## Fiona Donovan's musette bike bag

### You will need

- 10mm needles
- Zpagetti yarn (you can find it on the internet)
- 2 buttons
- Needle and thread

### Body of bag

- Cast on 14 stitches
- Knit first row
- Purl next row
- Continue in stocking stitch until bag when folded in  $\frac{1}{2}$  is the size you desire – I knitted about 30 rows

### Tabs

- With the flat knitting (right side facing) cast off 2 stitches knit the next 3 turn and knit (still keeping the stocking stitch) these to the tab – about 6 rows. Re-join yarn in the middle, next to the tab just knitted, cast off 4 stitches or until there are 5 stitches remaining. On the next row cast off two stitches and knit the remaining 3 stitches for 6 rows in stocking stitch
- Cast off
- Sew up the sides with either a large needle or a safety pin
- Sew on buttons – go ride your bike
